The DHBW Mosbach is one of nine DHBW locations. Its main campus is located in the town of Mosbach and its branch campus in Bad Mergentheim.

Two Campuses - Two Towns

Mosbach is located in the Neckar river valley, surrounded by ancient castles and steep vineyards. With its restored half-timbered houses it bears witness to its 1,200-year old history, yet some of the world's most innovative companies are located nearby.



Bad Mergentheim is steeped in history as well. Home of the Teutonic Order Knights since 1525, Bad Mergentheim is dominated by a mighty Renaissance castle where the campus is located today. It is also known as one of Germany's top health resorts.
